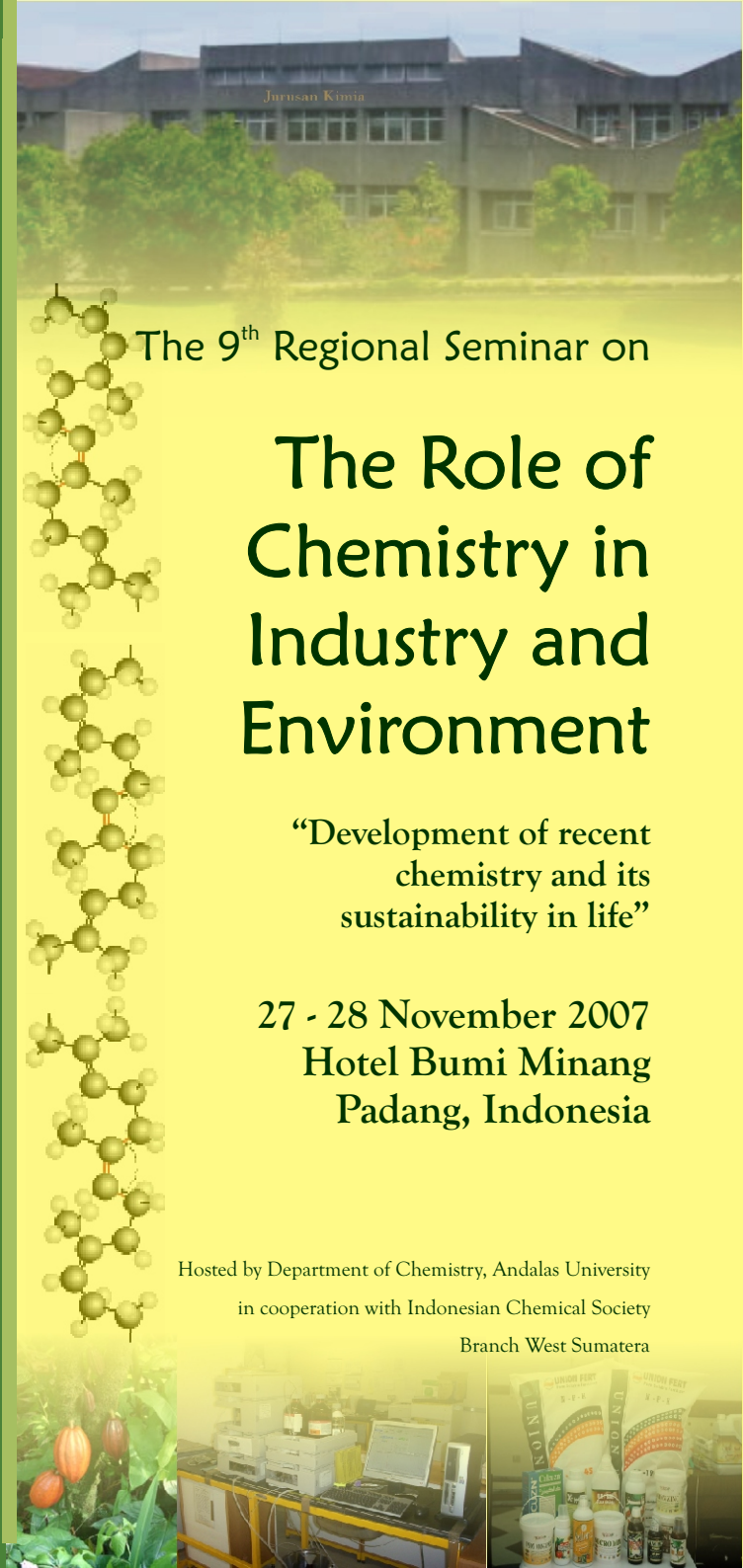

Author's Guide

Abstract is written in single-spaced 12-point, Times New Roman font and not more than 250 words include title in **boldface**, names of authors, institutional affiliation(s) and keyword. Abstract should be as informative as possible. **Please send** a softcopy of the abstract by e-mail to the Secretariat, with the registration form and payment before **September^{1st} 2007**. Abstract submitted by fax will not be accepted.

Full Manuscript is written in single-spaced, 10-point, Times New Roman font, in A4 paper, margins 3 cm all sides within two-column format. Clearly state the introduction, purpose, approaches or methods, results, conclusions, acknowledgement, and references. References in the text should be identified consecutively in Arabic numerals. List references in sequential order as they appear in the text. Manuscript must be submitted by e-mail directly to the Secretariat before **October 29th, 2007** if it is to appear in the Seminar Proceedings (softcopy only). Selected article will be published in national journal.

Poster will be on display throughout the duration of the meeting. Poster should be set up starting on the dates and times as determined by the organizer. Poster should be 1.2 m high x 0.8 m wide and should be readable from 1 m distance.
